

ATTENDANCE CHANGES AND WHAT THEY MEAN FOR ME

I'm a single parent of 1 child and want to go on holiday for a week

You must complete a holiday request form to notify us of your intended holiday. Your holiday will not be authorised. Because your child will miss 5 school days you will be given a penalty notice fine. The fine is £160, reduced to £80 if paid within 21 days.



A penalty is given for every child

1 parent with 4 children = £640, reduced to £320 if paid within 21 days

Irregular attendance '10 in 10'

If your child has 10 sessions of unauthorised absence within a rolling period of 10 school weeks, we will consider prosecution.

These sessions can be consecutive or not.

1 day = 2 sessions

3 days unauthorised absence week 1 + 1 per week for the next 2 weeks = 10 sessions

Both parents are fined for each child 2 parents with 4 children = £1280, reduced to £640 if paid within 21 days

Multiple holidays or patterns of irregular attendance within 3 years 2nd Time

2 parents and 1 child = £3202 children = £640

3 children = £960

4 children = £1280

3rd Time

No fine will be given. Instead, your case will be taken to court. A magistrate can fine each parent £2500 for each child

1 parent and 4 children - £10,000 2 parents and 4 children = £20,000

No discount for early payment
